Job Summary:

Perform highway and road maintenance tasks including repair, clearing, and upkeep of municipal, rural, and airport roads to ensure safe and functional travel.

Duties and Responsibilities:

- Repair roads on highways, town, and city roads; patch potholes and fill washouts.
- Operate machinery to dig, pour concrete, lay asphalt, and smooth surfaces.
- Repair guardrails and install signage including stop signs and speed limit signs.
- Plow snow, salt roads, and clear debris, brush, and fallen trees from roads.
- Paint dividing lines and maintain right-of-ways.
- Operate graders, loaders, backhoes, skid steers, tractors, dump trucks, and similar equipment.
- Patrol roads for hazards, snow/ice conditions, and maintenance/repair needs.
- Install and clean culverts and storm drains.
- Safely remove wildlife and other obstructions from roads.
- Inspect, service, and maintain equipment and vehicles, including fluid changes.
- Flag traffic and establish safe detours during road work.
